It was Comman'ded the Sheriff that he should take John Benn Sheriff of Charles County Sheriff of Va. and him safe & keep that you have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Neat County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in August Next to satisfy unto Samuel Luskitt as well the sum of Three pounds five shillings and seven pence half penny Currency which to the said Samuel in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justices afo. were adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of certain Promises and Assumptions to the said Samuel by the said John at Charles County afo. made and performed as also Two hundred and Eighteen Pounds of Tobacco which to the said Samuel of his afo. were adjudged for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this Part laid out and expensed whereof the said John is Convent and that he should have then and there that the said

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August afo. the Sheriff afo. did Return to the Court here that the said John Benn is deceased

the Writ afo. he Returns to the Court here the following supersedeas viz

Charles County vs You John Benn, John Wilber and John Wilcox Sheriff of this County do hereby Judgment to Samuel Luskitt of same County for the sum of Three pounds five shillings and seven pence Currency Debt and also Two hundred and Eighteen Pounds of Tobacco of the said Suit, together with, the additional Cost, which first sum was Pro. used by the said Samuel Luskitt against the said John Benn in our County Court together with the said sum of Tobacco, the said sum of money and Tobacco to be levied off your Rods, Goods and Chattels and Tenements for the use of the said Samuel Luskitt in have the said John Benn shall not Pay and Satisfie to the said Samuel Luskitt the said sum of money and Tobacco afo. mentioned, and about afo. proceed against him, with the additional Costs thereon, on the tenth Day of February Next.
