Therefore it is considered that the said Isaac Hayden before Six Hundred Pounds or Tobacco or Thirty Shillings Current Money for his offence as by the Court here adjudged according to the form force and Effect of the Act of Assembly in such Cases late made and provided and that the said Isaac be taken &c.

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes Richard Molyneux of Charles County Gentleman and becomes Plaintiff and Security for the said Isaac to pay the fine as also the several fees due to the officers and ministers of the Court here by reason of the Premises. — Whereupon it is by the Court here further considered that the said Isaac Hayden do give his master Richard Molyneux four more the said five Days Imprisonment of his paying the several fees due to the officers and ministers of the Court.

Recite that the said Isaac Hayden Recognize in the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money of Maryland with one Surety in the sum of Twenty Pounds like Money to keep the County of Charles free from any Parturition of the said bastard Child whereof this this day convicted.

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes the said Isaac Hayden and acknowledges himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money of Maryland and also in like manner came John Parkehar of same County and acknowledged himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto his said Lordship in the sum of Twenty Pounds like Money which sums they and each of them severally yielded and granted should remain a Lien on their and each of their body's Goods to be holden Lands or Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. — On Condition that the said Isaac Hayden do keep him self and maintain the County of Charles free from any Parturition of a bastard Child he be got on the body of Philip Calvert whereof he was this day convicted.
