 against the said Edward Sanders, in the plea etc. and the said John Smith Brother by
 said attorney etc. offers that the said Edward give special bail in the action etc.
 Whereupon into Court here in his proper person
 comes James Lewis of Charles County Justice and becomes pledge and security
 for the said Edward that it should happen that the said Edward in the plea etc. should
 be convicted that then the said James Lewis yielded and granted that as well the said
 Edward as all damages which to the said John Smith in this suit should be adjudged
 of his lands and chattels should be sold and devised to and for the use of the said
 John Smith if it should happen the said Edward should obtain damages as aforesaid to the said
 John Smith should not pay or his body into the custody of the sheriff by reason thereof
 And the said Edward Sanders by Henry Darnall his attorney
 comes on and defends the force and injury when the said Edward Sanders by his attorney
 here to wit the next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday
 and he hath and the same day is given to the said John Smith Brother here
 At which day to wit the second Tuesday in June after aid comes here,
 as will the said John Smith Brother as the said Edward Sanders by their attorney
 as aforesaid and the said Edward Sanders by his said attorney pray further leave to
 Impart here to wit the next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday
 in August next and he hath it, and the same day is given to the said John Smith
 At which day to wit the second Tuesday in August after aid comes here as
 will the said John Smith as the said Edward Sanders by their attorney as aforesaid
