Whose upon His Command the Sheriff that of this side Charles & the credit of the said Edward Murphy in his daily work, being he should attach as is at the bottom of one point & a quarter that in value is five pence Sterling and Eighteen pence and Nineteen Shillings and a proportion of currency Damages as Seven Hundred pounds of Tobacco for costs that had accrued and further should accrue in Prosecution of the same and when the same he had attached or any part thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the said Proprietary of his Neck County Court to be holden at his Town on the second Tuesday in August next then and there to be examined according to law to and for the use of the said Arthur Deacons unless the said Edward Murphy should come then and there by his own self or a full attorney and answer unto the said Arthur Deacons of a plea of Trover upon the same and that by God and lawful men of his daily work he should make known to the persons or persons in whose hands he should be the same Attachment that he shoud they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the Place and Time aforesaid to show cause if any he or they have why the same in their or any of their hands attached should not be found according to law and that the said Arthur Deacons have the execution of the same and have had the said Execution that writ that he should make known to the Justice aforesaid at the Time & Place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that writ and that names of those before whom he should make the same known &c.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August next comes the said Arthur Deacons by whom self or his attorney and offers himself against the said Edward & that plea and the Sheriff aforesaid returns to the Court then the writ aforesaid thus ordered by Charles County J^r. James by Contise to the Sheriff full the Justice within mentioned that by virtue of the within writ to me directed on the third day of August 1707 satisfied in the
