It was commanded the sheriff that he should take John Martindale late of Charles County Planter of the County and him of the County that he should have his body before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in August Next to answer unto some Parham and Francis Parham Adm^r of all and singular the goods Chattles Rights and Credits which were of John Parham late of Charles County Merchant deceased who died Intestate as is said of at his Executors upon the same upon the face and so forth and that they should have them and them West 86th

All which now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August afo^r comes the said Parham and Francis by seven parts their attorney afo^r and offers themselves against the said John Martindale on the Pleas afo^r that the said John in his Reply which is not found and that he hath left answering to the directions of the said Justice of the Peace in these cases demanded and provided a copy of the Declaration by

Charles County of the said John Martindale late of Charles County Planter was Attached to answer unto some Parham and Francis Parham Adm^r of all and singular the goods Chattles Rights and Credits which were of John Parham late of Charles County Merchant deceased who died Intestate as is said of at his Executors upon the same upon the face and so forth

And Whereupon the said some and Francis Adm^r afo^r by their attorneys Chase their attorney Complain for that whereas the said John on the tenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty four at Charles County afo^r was indebted unto the said John Parham in his lifetime in the sum of Seven pounds Three Shillings and a half penny for divers Particulars lying Properly in Account as by a Particular Account thereof now in Court brought may appear and the said John being so thereof paid in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same on the day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty four at the County afo^r upon himself assumed and to the same John Parham in his lifetime then and thereafter fully promised that he the said John Martindale the said sum of Seven pounds Three Shillings and a half penny to the said John Parham in his lifetime would well and truly Content and pay to him the same of Law and he should bequeath Nevertheless the said John Martindale in his lifetime and assumption afo^r made not in the least regarding bills minding and frauds but by Intending him the said John Parham in his last will and Testament to devise the said sum of Seven pounds Three Shillings and a half penny to him the said John in his lifetime, unto the said some and Francis afo^r after the Death of the said John to make Administration upon and singular the goods and Chattles Rights and Credits which were of the said John Parham at
