Whereupon the Court herein has first  
 Person Comes Tho<sup>rs</sup> Dent of Cha<sup>l</sup> County, <sup>planter</sup> and becomes Pledge and Security  
 For the afd<sup>r</sup> Henry Davis to pay the fine afd<sup>r</sup> and also the  
 Several fees Arisen due to the officers and ministers of the Court  
 Hereby occasion of the Premises.

It is Ordered that the said Henry Davis Recognize  
 In the sum of Twenty Pound Current money with sufficient  
 Security in the sum of Ten pounds like money for his good Behaviour  
 till and Appearance at the next County Court to be held Holden on the  
 Second Tuesday in June next.

Thereupon Into Court  
 here in his proper Person comes the aforesaid Henry Davis of Charles  
 County Planter and Thomas Dent of same County Planter and Acknowledge  
 themselves to owe and stand justly Indebted to the Right Honourable  
 The Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Henry in the sum of  
 Twenty Pound Current money and the said Thomas Dent in the sum  
 of Ten Pound like money which sums they and each of them  
 severally yielded and granted should and might be levied on  
 Their and each of their Goods and Chattels Land and Tenements  
 To and for the use of his said Lordship's heirs and Successors

The Conditions of which Recognizance is  
 That if the above bounden Henry Davis shall Personally appear  
 At the next County Court to be holden for this County to do and  
 Receive what shall be then and there enjoined by the said  
 Court and in the mean time that he be of good behaviour to ward  
 His Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this  
 Province then this Recognizance to be void otherwise to be and  
 Remain in full force and virtue.

Be it remembered that the afd<sup>r</sup> Henry Dav  
 Together with his main pernet John Sanders from the fore afd<sup>r</sup>  
 Effect of the Recognizance afd<sup>r</sup> taken as afd<sup>r</sup> before the Worship  
 Full m<sup>r</sup> William Gilbeck are acquitted and Discharged
