And the aforesaid Peter in his proper Person comes and defends the force and Injury when He afo. and says that he cannot deny the petition afo. of the said George herbert that he did assume upon him afo. in manner afo. as the said George above against him hath complained in law but that the said George hath did cause Damages by means afo. comprising the Breach and default afo. amount to seven Hundred and a few pounds of Tobacco as the said George afo. in Declaring his Plea

Whereupon the said George by his own and these his Attorneys afo. prays Judgment and these Damages to be acknowledged together with his costs and charges by him about his suit in this part laid out and expended to him to be adjudged

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said George do recover against the said Peter his Damages afo. amount to seven Hundred and four Pounds of Tobacco above acknowledged as also the sum of Two Hundred and fifty Nine Pounds of Tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part afo. and expended on his afo. of the Court here adjudged and the said Peter in remedy
