

August Court Errors Domini 1747

Complains that whereas the said George Maple the first day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand and Seventy six at Charles County was indebted to the said Samuel in the sum of Three Thousand one hundred and Twenty Three pounds of Tobacco previous Article lying property in an account as by the Particular Account thereof presented into Court brought may appear and being to the said the said George upon consideration being afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County afo. upon himself assumed and to the said Samuel then and there faithfully promised that he the said George the said sum of Three Thousand one hundred and Twenty Three pounds of Tobacco to the said Samuel when the same is after and he should be requested well and truly would content. Nevertheless the said George his Promise and Assumption afo. not regarding but minding to fraudulently Intending the same Samuel in this sort craftily and Subtly to receive and fraud the said George the said sum of Three Thousand one hundred and Twenty Three pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the said Samuel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented altho the said George afterwards to wit the first day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred & forty seven and often since at Charles County afo. by the said Samuel hath been to pay or him for the same in any sort to content the said George hath with to the said Samuel Requested but the same to him with to altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the damage of the same Samuel Six Thousand two hundred and forty Six pounds and therefore he brings suit and doth forth
