Samuel in this part should be judged of his lands and Chattles should be made and Levied to and for the use of the said Samuel that if it should happen that the said George the Damages and costs due to the said Samuel should not pay or his body into the hands of the said King by Reason thereof Render

And the said George in his proper Person Cometh Dependv the force and Injury when he said that he cannot deny the said maps of him the said nor but that he did assume upon in manner and form as the said Samuel against him ^{half} Explained nor also but that the said Samuel hath sustained Damages by means of not performing the Services and a sumptions aforesaid to Three Thousand one and Twenty Three pounds of Tobacco as the said Samuel above in defaulting supposed

Whereupon the said Samuel by his attorney afo prays Judgment and those Damages so acknowledged together with his costs & Charges by him about his Suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Samuel do Recover against the said George his Damages w^{ch} to Three Thousand one Hundred and Twenty Three pounds of Tobacco above acknowledged as also the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty one pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part laid out and Expended on his Account by the Court with these dayes

Charles County sh^r Alexander Sims being Charles County in the Province of Maryland to which with other wise called Alexander Sims of the County in the province aforesaid to which he was summoned to answer unto Samuel Churn of the said County that he owes unto him the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty one pounds of Tobacco which to him he owes and unjustly Detains and so forth

And Whereupon the same Samuel Churn by Simon his attorney saith that whereas the said Alexander Sims on the thirtieth Day of May in the year four and one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Three at Charles County sh^r by his Court and binding obligatory with the seal of him the said Alexander Sims sealed and here in Court Produced whose date is the day and year afo acknowledged himself to be bound and bound unto the said Samuel Churn in the said sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty one pounds of Tobacco, to be paid to the said Samuel Churn, when the said sum of money and he should be required Nevertheless the said Alexander Sims at this often Requested the said sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty one pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the said Samuel Churn ^{both not Paid} to pay or in any sort Content but the same to him the said Samuel Churn to pay or in any sort to Content both better to wit together Repaid and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the said Samuel Churn Six Thousand four Hundred Counts of Tobacco, and therefore Suit is brought and so forth
