Benjamin Taster, Daniel Dulany, Edward Lloyd, Benjamin Young,
Benjamin Taster Jun^r, & Richard Lee Esq^r. Robert Hanson, William
Penn Walter Hanson, John Winter, Robert Yates, Arthur Lee and Sam^l.
Hawkins or any of you, having taken the said Oaths, are hereby Impowred
to administer the same to the Justices and Commissioners respectively, as
they are Nominated in the within Commission, and we will that you, and
any of you, and every of you, having taken the said Oaths, do solemnly subscribe
the Test and Oath of Abjuration, and for so doing this shall be your
sufficient Warrant and authority, Howsoever, and when you have
the same so done, you are to Certify the same under your Hands and
Seals, to us in our High Court of Chancery with all convenient speed.

Governor and Chief Governour of our said Province of Maryland,
his Twenty fourth Day of October in the 33 year of our Dominion, &c.
