Beth remembered that pursuant to an Order of Court Holden al Shadles  
Town on the second Tuesday in August last Commission issued returnable  
from H<sup>r</sup> C<sup>o</sup> Examine Evidence touching the bounds of part of a tract of  
Land in the said County in suspicion of James Hankin in the  
Words following viz<sup>e</sup>

Charles County for Charles Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the  
Province of Maryland and Walton Lord Baronet to him next M<sup>r</sup> John  
Winter M<sup>r</sup> Benjamin Douglass Captain Samuel Chunn and Mr Peter  
Wood Gentlemen

Whereto James Hankin holds part of a tract of Land called Markers  
nest lying in the said County, did on the eleventh day of August being in the  
Thirty third year of his Dominion &c prefer his certain Petition in Writing to  
our Court, that is to say to our County Court, held at Charles Town, in and for  
the said County, on the day aforesaid before Robert H. Cannon Esq<sup>r</sup> and his  
Associates then and still our Justices within our County aforesaid, to Commission  
to examine Evidence to prove and perpetuate the Memory of the bounds of the  
Tract of Land according to the Directions of the Act of Assembly late made & provided  
Know ye, that we have given you, any three or two of you (nothing any way  
related to the petitioner, Contiguous Proprietor, nor interested in the said  
Land, and having taken the oath prescribed by the above named Act of Assembly  
(full Power and Authority to examine upon their corporal Oath, to be by you,  
any three, or two of you, Administrators, all Witnesses which shall be nominated to  
you, any three, or two of you, by the above named Petitioner, or other Person  
concerned, touching their knowledge of the bounds of the tract of Land above  
named, or the bounds of any other Land, wherein the said Tract depends, or where it  
adjoins, and thereupon command you, any three or two of you, that you call and  
cause to come before you, any three, or two of you, all Witnesses so nominated at  
a certain Day by you, or any three, or two of you, to be apprised upon the abovesaid  
Tract of Land, and the Examination of every Witness so called before you, that you, my  
three, or two of you receive, and thereupon command you, any three or two of you, —  
carefully reduce into Writing, in the presence of a Justice concerned that shall be there  
present, and the Examination so taken ase<sup>d</sup> you, any three, or two of you, are to return  
to the Justices of our Court, with all convenient Speed under your Seal, or the Seal  
of any three, or two of you, together with this Writ. Provided always that all Parties concerned  
living within or without the County aforesaid have Notice according to the Directions of the  
Act of Assembly before mentioned, of the day and place of the Execution of this writ  
before the Execution thereof, and that you, any three, or two of you, and to return to  
our Justices aforesaid, with all convenient Speed, a Certificate of such Notice, to
