The Road from Francis Gray's to Mattawoman Road from Jacob's to the Old Mattawoman Road to Richard Wheelers Mill, the Road that strikes out of Mattawoman Road to the Huckleberry Branch and also a Road from Eads Hanson's Road, by the Plantation, where Edward Madder formerly lived, to Daniel Rowens also from Mr. Payne Smathers to Warbers Run by John Davis to Nanjony Church. —

The Road leading from Benjamin Swinn North Line Down to the bottom of Cobneck. —

The Road from the manner Branch to the upper borders of the County from the Upper Bridge across one creek to Paul Rawlings Run, from a place called the three Chesnuts to Lee's Quarter also the Road which formerly led from James Sailors by the Widow Thidwells till it intersects the back Road. —

The Road from Piles Fresh to Benedict Creek from Piles fresh up the swamp by Oliver to anchor to the extent of the County and the Road that strikes out of the Road from Piles Fresh to Benedict Creek towards a path Church to the border of the County. —

The Road leading below Richard Thompson to Allen's fresh and from the new Bridge to Allen's Fresh and from Allen's fresh the new Road turning out by Mrs. Fendall's old House to Benjamin Swinn's Land. —
