Up Therefore it is considered by the Court here that this said William Campbell should serve five days for one and fourteen months for the Tobacco & Money

Thomas Richards makes oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that Peter Montgomery (as he apprehends) whom he has caused to be summoned is a Material Evidence for him in a Cause now depending betwixt this Deponent and Bernard Johnson Newling

William Coge Jurate Court that he was overtrayed one day last year

William Bryan makes oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he attended five days for Alexander McPherson against & against Doctor

James Ekattom makes oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he attended four days as an Evidence for Timothy Mauer against Thomas Wood

Emmett has authorized & offered for James Simpson to answer the Complaint of his servant

Matthew Priedon on his motion, to the Court is allowed Twelve Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for sleeping on or upon any Tally from January Last this Court

Thomas Harrison makes oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that to the best of his Knowledge, either Harrison his mother, was not allowed for any Squirrel Heads last year, which he ought to have been allowed for Twenty one Squirrel Heads

John Franklin makes oath D<sup>o</sup> that he was not allowed for Forty Seven Squirrel Heads last year for which he ought to have

Francis Gray makes oath D<sup>o</sup> that he was <sup>not</sup> allowed Sixty Three Squirrel Heads last year for which he ought to have

John Coons makes oath D<sup>o</sup> that he was not allowed Sixty Squirrel Heads last year for which he ought to have

Abraham Simmes makes oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he attended seven days as an Evidence for John Mearns Junior against Alexander Smith Hawkins, which was burnt in November Court 1746 which was burnt amongst the Court Papers
