Alexander Smith Hawkins Esq. refer to the Court here the following Petition Viz<sup>z</sup>— To the worshipfull the Justices of Charles County now sitting— The Petition of Alexander Smith Hawkins of Charles County Humbly sheweth that your Petitioner being seized, and in Possion of a Tract or Parcel of Land called Moretown lying and being in Charles County aforesaid, and your Petitioner being desirous to prove and perpetuate the bounds of said Land, Prays your worship will be Pleas'd to Appoint Commissioners, and grant a Commission for that Purpose, and Your Petitioner as in duty bound will Pray and swear.
