Lordships Writ of Habeas Corpus in these Words following to wit
Maryland &c. Charles Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Water Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Justices and Sheriff of Charles County greeting where as a certain Richard Martin of Charles County Plaintiff is Detained in the Prison of your said County under the custody of your said Sheriff at the suit of a certain Barton of Hangerford in plea of Trespass which said plea as it is said still depends before your said Justices undetermined as aforesaid should be undetermined before the Justices of our provincial Court Therefore We command you that you have the body of the said Richard Martin by what name he be called in the plea aforesaid with the day and Cause of his Captivity Detained
