Charles County for John Ratcliffe late of Charles County Sheriff was attached to Announce John Mannere of plea of Inevity upon the Law

And Whereupon the said John Mannere by his attorney Complaies for that whereas the said John Ratcliffe of the Ninth day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and forty five at Charles County aforesaid was Indebted unto the said John Mannere the sum of Eight thousand Eighty six p. of Tobacco for divers particular lying property in amount as by a particular account lying hereunto brought in by aforesaid and the said John Ratcliffe being afterwards in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid in the County aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said John Mannere then and then faithfully promised that he the said John Ratcliffe the said sum of Eight thousand and Eighty six p. of Tobacco to the said John Mannere would well and truly content and pay when the same afterwards he should be required to Requested Nevertheless the said John Ratcliffe his promise and Assumption aforesaid inform aforesaid made not in the least regarding but mending and fraudulent by involving him the said John Mannere in this path Covetous of Usurpation to receive and receive the said John Ratcliffe the said sum of Eight thousand and Eighty six p. of Tobacco or any part thereof to the said John Mannere hath not paid ordinary sort Contented with the said John Ratcliffe was on the Twenty fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty six and often before and since at Charles County aforesaid by the said John Mannere Requested but the said John Ratcliffe the said sum of Eight thousand and Eighty six p. of Tobacco or any part thereof to the said John Mannere to pay ordinary sort to Content both hither to altogether Refused and detraeth Refuse to the Damage of him the said John Mannere Twenty thousand and Sixty pounds of Tobacco and therefore bringing suit
