And Whereupon the said James & Bond by their attorney complain for that whereas the said Joseph on the sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty five at Charles County ap^o was indebted unto the said James & Bond in the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty two pounds of Toba for divers Particulars by in a particular account thereof peruse with into Court brought may appear and the said Joseph being so thereof indebted in consideration thereof afterwards (to wit) the day and year afo^o at the County ap^o upon himself appeared and to the same James & Bond then & there faithfully promised that he the said Joseph the said sum of fifteen hundred and fifty two pounds of Toba to them the said James & Company would well and truly content and pay when thereunto afterwards he should be required & he overthrew the said Joseph his promise & assumption afo^o inform afo^o made in the last regarding but in doing and fraudulently inducing them the said the said James & Company in this manner and subtly to receive and accept of the said Joseph the said sum of fifteen hundred and fifty two pounds of Toba or any part thereof to them the said James & Company hath not paid or in any sort contented Altho' the said Joseph was on the second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty six and often before and since at Charles County ap^o by the said James & Company requested both the said Joseph the said sum of fifteen hundred and fifty two pounds of Toba or any part thereof to them the said James & Company pay or in any sort to content hath either refused and still doth refuse to the damage of them the said James & Bond three thousand one hundred pounds of Toba and therefore with brought herewith
