Whereupon into Court here in his proper person comes Mr. Joseph Person Sen<sup>r</sup> of Charles County Planter and becomes pledge and security for the said Joseph that if it should happen the said Joseph in the plea afo<sup>r</sup> should be convicted that then the said William Tyndal should pay the Damages afo<sup>r</sup> and costs which to the said James & Company in this part should be adjudged of his Lands and Chattels should be made and levied to and for the use of the said James & Co. and if it should happen that the said Joseph the Damages & Costs afo<sup>r</sup> to the said James & Co. should not pay or his body into the Custody of the Sheriff by Reason thereof.

And the said Joseph in his proper person comes and defends the force of Injury therein &c. and says that he cannot deny the action afo<sup>r</sup> of them the said James & Company nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said James & Company against him hath complained nor also but that the said James & Company hath sustained Damages by me and of not performing the Promises and Assumptions aforesaid to one Thousand five Hundred and fifty Two Pounds of Tobacco as the said James & Company above in declaring supplic<sup>s</sup>

Whereupon the said James & Company by their attorneys Chase their Attorney aforesaid prays Judgment and those Damages so acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this part laid out & Expended to them to be adjudged

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said James & Company do Recover against the said Joseph the Damages afo<sup>r</sup> to one Thousand five Hundred and fifty Two pounds of Tobacco above acknowledged as also Three Hundred and Ninety Eight pounds of Tobacco for his Costs & Charges by him about his Suit in that part laid out and Expended on his behalf by the Court here adjudged and the said Joseph in 1717 &c.
