 to the Court here brought. In her proper Person Comed It being Demanded of her
 Whether she be guilty of the Bastardy afo. above upon her Imposed she the said
 Prymus saith that she is guilty of the Bastardy afo. In manner and form as
 by the Presentment above against her It is alleaged
 It is therefore Considered by the Court here that the said Prymus be fined or
 suffer Corporal Punishment. And for that the said Prymus cannot pay or
 Procure any Person to be security for the payment of the fine afo. by the afo. Act
 Imposed It is ordered that the Sheriff take the said Prymus to the whipping
