And Whereupon the said Robert by his Attorney complains that whereas the said Thomas Hungerford the twenty first day of August in the year our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven at Charles County afo. was indebted to the said Robert in the sum of one thousand five hundred and sixty seven pounds of Tobacco for such articles as by property in and value as by the Particulars annexed thereto brought into Court brought may appear and being so the said Thomas in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day & year afo. at the County afo. upon himself assumed and to the said Robert then & there faithfully promised that he the said Thomas the said sum of one thousand five hundred and sixty seven pounds of Tobacco to the said Robert when the said Thomas should be demanded or lawfully would content and pay Nevertheless the said Thomas being afterwards his promise and assumption afo. not regarding but mindfully & fraudulently intending the said Robert in this Barter craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said Thomas the said sum of one thousand five hundred & sixty seven pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the said Robert hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort contented as the said Thomas afterwards to wit the twenty fifth day of August in the year and at the County afo. & often since by the said Robert hath been the said sum requested but the said Thomas hath refused or him for the same in any sort to content the said Thomas Hungerford hath likewise refused on a still doth refuse to the damage of the said Robert Gilpin three thousand one hundred and thirty four pounds of Tobacco and therefore
