November Court Anno Domini 1741

The sum of six hundred Pounds of Tobacco and no more Damages as via Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for costs that had accrued and that further should accrue into possession of the Premises and when the same had attained any part thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Neel County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November Next then & there to be forewarned according to Law to and for the use of the said towing unless the said Warrant should come then and there by him self or Lawfull attorney and answer unto the said Warrant of Justice upon the same and that by good and Lawfull men of his County which he should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands he should make the same attachment that he should be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and Time aforesaid to show Cause if any he should or they have why the same in their or any of their hands should not be condemned according to Law and the said towing have the force of Execution if it should be so that he should Execute the said Warrant that he should make known to the Justice aforesaid at the time and Place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that Warrant that among those before whom he should make the same known &c.

And on the second Tuesday in November aforesaid comes the said towing by Jeremiah Chase his attorney and offers himself against the said Warrant in the plea aforesaid the Sheriff aforesaid Returns to the Court that the Warrant aforesaid thus Endorsed

Charles County f. I hereby certify to the Worshipfull the Justice within mentioned that by Virtue of their within Warrant to me Directed on the 11. 7th of 1741 I attached in the hands of John B. Smith, and Thomas Speake, and on the 11th of the same month in the hands of John B. Daggot in each of their hands the whole Damages and Costs, within mentioned as the Effects of the within Named Warrant known to transfer the use of towing Speake, and I have made known to the Justice aforesaid as above mentioned that they be and appear before the Justice aforesaid at the Time and place within prescribed to show Cause why the said Effects so attached in their hands should not be condemned according to Law before nobly Messrs. James Smith and William Stoddleton Junr. Good & Lawfull men of my County which I am hereby Comanded

And the said John Smith, unto Court here in his proper person comes and Confesses that at the time of laying the attachment aforesaid he has and still has of the Effects of the said Warrant known to the Value of five Hundred & fifteen Pounds of Tobacco and no more. the said Thomas Speake in like manner Confesses three Hundred and sixteen Pounds of Tobacco and no more, the said John Baggot in like manner Confesses three Hundred and sixty Pounds of Tobacco
