Whereas William Bryan did this day come before me one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County afo. and made Oath on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God that W^m Bart Knowles is justly indebted unto him in the sum of Six pounds Eleven Shillings & ninepence half penny Currency and Eighteen Hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco and that the said W^m Bart Knowles is Ran away &

These are therefore in his Lordships Name to Request you Immediately to Issue Attachment against the Effects of the said W^m Bart Knowles for the use of the said William Bryan according to the directions of the Acts of Assembly made in this behalf and provided and to befall not given under my hand and Seal this 27th day of Sept^r 1747

Whereupon it was commanded that hereby that of this date Charles Knowles & heirs of the said W^m Bart Knowles in his daily week being he should Attach as well the sum of Six pounds Eleven Shillings & ninepence half penny Currency and Eighteen Hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco Damages as one thousand pounds of Tobacco for costs that he should incur and that further should incur in prosecution of the same and when the same he had attached or any part thereof that he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his real County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in August Next then there to be examined according to Law to and for the use of the said William Bryan unless the said W^m Bart Knowles should come then & there by himself or lawful Attorney and answer unto the said W^m Bart Knowles of the said W^m Bart Knowles the case and that by good men of his daily week he should make known to the Baron or Person in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he should be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the time and place afo. to their cause if any he should have or by this return in which or any of their hands attached should not be examined according to Law and the said William Bryan should have Execution if he should die that he should make the same known &c.

Mr now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in November afo. comes the said William Bryan by John his attorney & offers himself against the said W^m Bart Knowles in the plea afo. and the Sheriff afo. Returns to the Court here the writ afo. thus Indorsed
