Whereupon Thomas Comm and the sheryff that of the goods & chattels of the said said Gates in his Bailiwick being heretofore attached and the sum of Twelve Hundred & Twenty four pence of Tobacco Damages as in the said Bonds of Tobacco for bonds that had accrued and that he should answer prosecution of the premises and when the same he had attached or impounded that he should have before the Justice of the said Proprietary of this Neck County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November next then & there to be considered according to Law to and for the use of the said Joseph unless the said said Gates should send there by himself or a lawful attorney or otherwise unto the said Justice of the said said Proprietary upon the case and that by good & lawful men of this Bailiwick he should make known to the Justice or Justices in whose hands he should make the same attachments that he or they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and time aforesaid to shew cause if any he should have why the same in their or any of their hands attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Joseph have the Execution of the said said Bonds and should declare that that he should make known to the Justice of the said said Court and place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that he and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c.
