Whereas it has been made appear to me that Peter Card stand as provided unto Samuel Hanson Junr in the sum of nineteen hundred & forty five pounds of Money & that he said Peter is deceased from his late place of abode These are therefore in his Lordships name to command you on sight hereof to issue Attachment against the goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of the aforesaid Peter for the sum aforesaid as also what Costs have or shall accrue in prosecuting the said writ of Attachment and for your so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant & Authority given under my hand this 24th October 1747
