Whereupon it was commanded the sheriff that of the peace he had the & duties of the  
 aforesaid Peter said in his behalf being his own attachment as well the sum of  
 Nineteen hundred and forty two pounds of Tobacco Damages as one thousand  
 Pounds of Tobacco for bonds that had been and that further should enquire in prosecution  
 of the same and when the same should be attached every part thereof that he  
 should have before the Justice of the Peace Proprietary of his Neck County Court  
 to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November next that he should  
 be bound according to law to stand for the use of the said Samuel and that the  
 Peter should come himself and that by himself or his attorney and servants  
 the said Samuel of plea of Justification the law and that by God and lawful wrong  
 his behalf make known to the person or persons in whose hands he  
 should make the same attachment that he or they be and appear before the Justice  
 of the said Proprietary at the place and time aforesaid to show cause if any he should they  
 have why the sum in their or any of their hands attached should not be returned  
 according to law and the said Samuel having the Execution of 25. and more  
 the said Justice that that he should make known to the Justice of P. at the  
 time and place aforesaid and that he should have them and then that he should and the  
 Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c.

And now here at this day to  
 wit the second Tuesday in November aforesaid comes the said Samuel in his proper person  
 and offers himself against the said Peter in the place aforesaid and the Sheriff returns to  
 the Court he is the said Peter thus endorsed

 further certify that at the same time I attached in the hands of William Bird since  
 the Effects of the within named Peter said to and for the use of the said Hanson the  
 sum of Two thousand Pounds of Tobacco and I have made known to the persons  
 above mentioned that they be and appear before the Justice of P. at the time and place  
 within prescribed to know cause if they or either of them have why the said Effects so  
 attached in their hands should not be returned for the use of the said Hanson before  
 I and his Green Seal & Elements and good & lawful men of my Sheriffship of Sam:
