

November Court Anno Domini, 1707

Charles County. In the 25th day of October 1707 came Sam: Hanson Jun: before me the undersigned one of his excellency's Justices for said County & made oath on the Holy Evangelists to Almighty God that the above account is just & true & that he neither he nor any person for him has ever received any part or parcel thereof or any security for satisfaction for the same to the best of his knowledge

Charles County. Whereas it hath been made appear to me Sam: Hanson Jun: that Robertin Wth Blois is indebted unto him in the sum of one thousand and two pounds of Tobacco, and that the said Blois is Absconded & Ran away from his late Place of abode These are therefore in his Excellency's the Right Honorable Lord Proprietor's name to Command you to give all what aid & assistance you shall see fit to the Rights and Debts of the said Blois, and to cause him to be arrested & imprisoned of Tobacco as for what Costs have or shall accrue in prosecuting the said Debt. In witness whereof I have signed this 25th day of October 1707

Whereupon It was Commanded that Henry of the goods Charles & Robert of the said William, in his last will being bequeathed unto the sum of one thousand & two pounds of Tobacco Damages as Eight thousand pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued but further should accrue in prosecution of the premises and when the same he had obtained any part thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the Peace of his Next County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday next thereafter and there to be sold according to Law to and for the use of the said Samuel unless the said William should come then and there by himself or a lawful Attorney and answer unto the said Samuel a plea of Captivity upon the Oath and that by God's lawful Oath he should make known to the Court or Persons in whose hands or respective Oaths the same Attachment that he or they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietor at the place and time aforesaid to show cause if any he shall they have why the same for their change of his Oath and Attachment should not be continued according to Law and that the said Sam: shall have Execution of 100^l and how he shall execute that that he shall make known to the Justice aforesaid at the time and place aforesaid and that he shall have then and there that with and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c

And now read at this day with the second Assize in Tobacco &c aforesaid comes the said Samuel in his Oath and answers himself against the said William in the plea aforesaid and the Sheriff returns to the Court due the Oath aforesaid have passed

Charles County. Henry Certifies to the Justice within mentioned that by Virtue of the within writ he directed that on the 21st day of October 1707 attached in the hands of Henry James Junior the whole Damages & Costs before John Jenkins & James Bush Jun: and there made known to the Garnantee of the said William Blois within mentioned that he
