Mr. Daniel Stephenson vs

John McEacherson Judgment of Cognovit Action

Charles County sh^r: John McEacherson late of Charles County Planter was attached to answer unto Daniel Stephenson of the County of Frederick upon the 24th of June Whereupon he came Daniel by Jeremiah Chesnut his Attorney complains that whereas the said John the Twenty Seventh day of September last he gave Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven at Charles County sh^r was indebted to the said Daniel in the sum of eight hundred & seventy seven pounds of Tobacco for diverse articles lying properly in an account as by the particular account thereof hereunto into Court brought may appear and being so there of indebted the aforesaid John in his Oath sworn there afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said Daniel then and there faithfully promised that he the aforesaid John the said sum of eight hundred and seventy seven pounds of Tobacco to the said Daniel when thereunto afterwards he should be required and that he would content and pay Nevertheless the aforesaid John his promise and assumption aforesaid not regarding but in sin and fraud and in the name of Daniel in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid John the said sum of eight hundred & seventy seven pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the said Daniel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort contented with the said John afterwards to wit the Twentieth day of August last year gave Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven and often afterwards at Charles County aforesaid by the name Daniel hath been required but the same to him hitherto to pay or him for the same in any sort to content hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same Daniel one thousand seven hundred & fifty four pounds of Tobacco and therefore suit is brought for the
