

November Court Anno Domini 1747

That whereas the said John on the 25th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty six at Charles County aforesaid by his certain Writing obligatory with the seal of him the said John sealed and remain in force produced whose date is the day and year aforesaid acknowledged himself to be and firmly bound unto the said Samuel in the sum of two thousand one hundred & twenty six pounds of good Tobacco to the said Samuel when thereunto afterwards he should be required Nevertheless the said John after often Requests the said sum of two thousand one hundred and twenty six pounds of good Tobacco or any part thereof to him the said Samuel to pay or satisfy in full the content both together refused and did doth refuse to the damage of him the said Samuel our thousand three hundred and fifty two p. of good Tobacco and therefore suit is brought forth

And the said John by Thomas Clark his Attorney Comes & Defends the plea and injury when &c. and prays a hearing of the Writing obligatory, and it is read unto him he also prays a hearing of the condition of the above Writing and it is read unto him in the words following viz

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound John McDonald do and shall not and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Samuel Hanson Junr. his certain attorney &c. the sum of one thousand and eighty eight pounds of good Tobacco in cash Current at or upon the 25th day of April next ensuing the date hereof with legal interest for the same then the above obligation to be void & to remain in full force and virtue in law but if default be made in the payment of the said sum of one thousand and eighty eight pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid then I do hereby empower any attorney in any Court of law in the Realm of Great Britain France or Ireland or within the Province of Maryland or other his Majesty's Dominions to appear for me at the suit of the above mentioned Samuel Hanson Junr. and to receive a declaration on the above obligation, and thereupon to confess Judgment by Nisi in Cognovit actionem, Nonsum Informatus or otherwise by releasing all the Errors that may happen upon the said Judgment. without Exception thereupon or in any of the proceedings thereunto Relating
