Whereupon the said Samuel by Jeremiah Case his attorney etc. prays Judgment and those Damages & Costs adjudged together with his Costs & Charges by him about his suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Samuel do Recover against the said Arthur the Damages aforesaid Eight Hundred and Sixty Nine pounds of Tobacco above and above the said Arthur the sum of Two Hundred and Seventy five pounds of Tobacco for his Costs & Charges by him about his suit in that part laid out & Expended on his behalf by the Court here as in and by the said Judgment and the said Arthur in Money &c

It was Comanded the Sheriff that he should take Charles Courts late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Charles Courts of Charles County Sheriff of the County and him safe to prison that he should have his body before the Justice of the Peace of this next County Court to be holden at Charles Towne the second Tuesday in November next to answer unto M^{rs} Stephenson and Steel of plea that the said Courts unto them the sum of Three Thousand one Hundred and Seventy Two pounds Tobacco with to them he owes and wrongfully detains and so forth and that he should have them &c

At which day to wit the second Tuesday in November afores. Comes the said Stephenson & Steel by Jeremiah Case their attorney and offers themselves against the said Charles and the Sheriff aforesaid Returns to the Court here that he has taken the body of the said Charles Courts

With the aforesaid Charles Courts in his proper person Comes and defends the plea and in answer thereto saith that he knows of no Plea the said Courts offer the said Stephenson & Steel nor but that he owes to them the said Stephenson & Steel the sum of Three Thousand one Hundred and Seventy Two pounds of Tobacco and no more

Therefore it is Considered that the said Stephenson & Steel do Recover against the said Charles their Deb^t aforesaid & his Damages by reason of Detaining that Deb^t to one Thousand and Ninety two pounds of Tobacco to the same Stephenson & Steel on their behalf by the Court here as in and by the said Judgment and the said Charles Courts in Money &c
