Sam Hanson Junr. Debts Judgment to or
Daniel Hodgkins Judgment for Nonsum Informaticus

Charles County, sh. Daniel Hodgkins late of Charles County in the presence of
Maryland Planter was summoned to answer unto Samuel Hanson Junr
a plea that he should undertake him the Just & full sum of six Thousand three
Hundred & forty pounds of Tobacco, which to him he owes & unjustly detains, & so forth
And thereupon the same Samuel in his proper person saith that he was
the said Daniel on the Thirtieth first Day of October In the year of our Lord one Thousand
Seven Hundred and forty Six at Charles County sh. by his certain Writing
Obligatory with the said Daniel sealed and hereunto put
whose Date is the day & year aforesaid he acknowledged himself to be bound and sworn by
bound unto the said Samuel In the sum of six Thousand three Hundred
forty pounds of Tobacco to the said Samuel when thereunto afterwards he
should be required, Nevertheless the said Daniel afterwards Requested
the said sum of six Thousand three Hundred & forty pounds of Tobacco, or
any part thereof to him the said Samuel to pay in any sort to Content
with the other's altogether Refused and said so the Refuse to the Damages of
him the said Daniel Three Thousand six Hundred and eighty pounds of Tobacco
and therefore said he brought it so forth

And the said Daniel by his Attorney Come and defende before and
Injury when &c. and pray a hearing of the Writing Obligatory and it is read unto him
he also pray a hearing of the condition of the same Writing and it is read unto him in
the words following to wit

The condition of the above Obligations such that if the above bounden Daniel
Hodgkin his Heirs Exors admors do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid
unto the said Samuel Hanson Junr his certain Attorney Exors admors or Assignes
the Just sum of Three Thousand one Hundred & twenty pounds of Good sound Merchantable
Leaf Tobacco in value to Content, the same with legal Interest for the same then the above
Obligations to be void Else to remain in full force and Value in Law but if Default be
made in the payment of the said sum of Three Thousand one Hundred and twenty
pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof then I do here by Impower any Attorney in any County
Record in the Realm of Great Britain France or Ireland or within the provinces of Wales
or other his Majesty's Dominions to appear for me at the suit of the above mentioned
Samuel Hanson Junr; and to receive a Declaration on the above obligations, and
thereupon to Confess Judgment by Nil dicit Cognovit actum, Nonsum Informaticus
or otherwise hereby releasing all the Errors that may happen on the said Judgment
being sub Execution there upon or in any of the proceedings thereunto relating
Which being read and heard the said Daniel by his Attorney aforesaid defende
before and Injury when &c. and the same Attorney saith that he is not informed by
the said Daniel of any answer to make for the said Daniel to the said Samuel in the action
of the said Samuel by which the same Samuel remains against the said Daniel thereby
without Defense
