Charles County J^r Robert Green late of Charles County Planter was attached to answer unto Ann Clark of the said County a suppliant the case
 And the reason the said Ann by Henry Darnall her Attorney complains that whereas the said Robert on the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord 1746, the said Ann and for at Charles County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Ann in the sum of four Thousand pounds of J^r by the particular Count and there of herewith into Court brought may appear and being taken up by the said Robert in consideration, the said Ann did then and thereupon at the County and within the Jurisdiction aforesaid upon himself promise and to the said Ann then and thereupon fully promised that he the said Robert the said sum of four Thousand pounds of J^r to the said Ann when he should afterwards the said sum Requested would well and truly Content pay, also whereas the said Robert a few days before on the sixteenth day of Nov^r in the year at the County within the Jurisdiction aforesaid in consideration that the said Ann then had at the County and Request of him the said Robert let and hired out to the said Robert a certain Negroe Slave called Jack the proper Slave of her the said Ann from the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord 1746 until the fifth day of December to the said fifth day of November above mentioned the said Robert did then upon undertake and the said Ann did then and thereupon fully Promise that he the said Robert would well and truly pay and satisfy to the said Ann when he should be there unto afterwards Requested such sum of J^r as the said Ann should Reasonably Desire for the full Value of her Negroe aforesaid and the said Ann in full faith that the said Reasonable Demand for the full Value of her Negroe aforesaid to the said Robert the sum of four Thousand pounds of J^r and thereupon the said Robert then and thereupon in the year of our Lord 1746 Hundred forty five aforesaid at the County and within the Jurisdiction aforesaid give notice to the said Ann Robert that the said Robert in nowise regarding his several Promises and undertakings aforesaid made but contriving the said Ann craftily and Subtly to deceive in this Particular the said several times or any thereof to the said Ann hath not paid nor in any manner satisfied her for the same altho to do this the said Robert after several times in the days in the year at the County within the Jurisdiction aforesaid was Requested by the said Ann but he hath altogether hitherto Refused and still doth Refuse to pay or in any way to satisfy her for the same by Reason whereof the said Ann saith she is the worse and hath Damage to the Value of Eight Thousand pounds of J^r and therefore she brings suit as aforesaid
