It was Commanded the Sheriff of the County of Charles and Credits of the said John Nally in his Bailynick being he should attach as well the Damages aforesaid as well as fifteen Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for Costs as aforesaid and when the same or any part thereof he had attached that he should have it before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary of his Neel County Court to be held at Charles Town aforesaid on the second in November Next then and there to be Condemned according to Law to and for the use of the said Samuel unless the said John should come then and there by himself or Lawfull attorney and Answer unto the said Samuel of plea of Trespass upon the case and that by Good and Lawfull men of his Bailynick he should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands he made the same Attachment that he or they be and appear before the Justices aforesaid at the day and Place aforesaid to shew Cause if any he or they have why the same in their or any of their hands Attached should not be Condemned and that the said Samuel have thereof Execution if he should so desire and that the said John should make known unto the Justices aforesaid at the day and Place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that Writ and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known

Comes this said Samuel by sworn attornies his attornies aforesaid and offers himself against the said John in the plea aforesaid and one of the Corners of the County aforesaid Returns to the Court here the Writ aforesaid of the said

So the worshipfull the Justices within mentioned shew by Certificate that by Virtue of the within Writ to me Directed that on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1747 Attached in the hands of William Nally Sunday Effects of the within mentioned John Nally for the use of the within Named Samuel Hanson amounting to the sum of one Thousand Nine Hundred Pounds of Tobacco as appears by Schedule of Appraisment hereunto annexed and have made known to the above Garnishee that he be and appear at the Time and Place within mentioned to shew Cause if any he hath why the said Effects so Attached in his hands should not be Condemned to and for the use of the said Samuel Hanson according to Law Attached before William M<sup>r</sup> Johnson Jun<sup>r</sup> and Charles Inoet Good and Lawfull men of my Bailynick as Jam<sup>r</sup> hereby Commanded to Answer
