Whereupon I was Commanded the Sheriff that of the Goods Chattels & Credits of the for said John Blaney in his Realty with being he should attach and sell the sum of Seventeen Shilling and six pence current money and five Hundred & forty pounds of Tobacco Damages in Seven Hun & Sound of Tobacco for costs that had accrued and that further should issue in prosecution of the premises a warrant the same he had attached or any part thereof that he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Seat County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Sunday in March: That then and then to be condemned according to Law and for the use of the said Joseph Allen unless the said John Blaney should come then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and answer unto the said Joseph Allen of a plea of Responde pro the Case and that by God and Lawfull men of his Realty with he should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hand or hands the same attachment had been or they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and time aforesaid to show cause if any he should they have why the same, their or any of their hands attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Joseph Allen have full Execution, if V. B. and how he should execute that Writ that he should make known to the Justice aforesaid at the time and place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that Writ and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c.

And now here at this day to wit the second Sunday in March aforesaid comes the said Joseph Allen by Sereniate his attorney and offers himself against the said John Blaney in the plea aforesaid and the Sheriff aforesaid returns to the Court here the Writ aforesaid thus endorsed

Charles County sh. To the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Justices within mentioned shew by Certificate that on the second day of March 1746 I attached in hands of Joseph Allen sundry Goods as the Effects of the within mentioned John Blaney for the use of the within mentioned Joseph Allen amounting to Six hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco and fifteen Shilling of Currency as appears by a schedule of Appraisement hereto annexed and have made known to the above garnishes that he be and appear at the time and place within mentioned to show cause why the Effects attached in his hand should not be condemned according to Law
