Ruled that the said Thomas Burnett give security for
the several fees herein due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court hereby
Occasion of the Summons. Whereupon into Court here in due proper Person
James Brandt of Charles County & Carter and by some pledge and security for
the said Thomas to pay the several fees aforesaid
