Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person came the afo. Jacob Andrew Minitia and Acknowledges himself to owe and stand bound and indebted unto his Majesty the Lord Proprietary in the sume of Fifty Pounds Current Money of Maryland and also in like manner came in Carter Wares and John Hammill and Acknowledges themselves to owe and stand bound and indebted unto his said Lordship in the sume of Twenty five pounds Current Money each which said sumes they severally yielded & granted to be made and paid on their and every of their bodily goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs & assigns

On condition that the said Jacob Andrew Minitia do make his Personal Appearance at the next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in June next & in the mean time to keep the Peace and be of good Behaviour to all his Majesty's Subjects and particularly to the before mentioned Priscilla Pearson

Ordered by the Court here that the Sheriff Say John Moore 2000 Sol. out of the Treasurers Office in the Name of his Majesty's Majesty

Ordered by the Court here that M^r. John Minter and M^r. Robert Yates do agree with some Workmen to Repair Wares Ford Bridges as they shall think fit

Margaret Chapman being present here in Court in her proper person prays that her summons may be for certain Joseph Mankin to appear before the Justices here to show cause why he detaineth a certain Josias Mankin Orphan of her said Margaret
