Know William M'pherson on Jun^r 16th

vs George Towne

Judgment by Cognovit Actionem
State of Carolina to the 1. May

It was commanded the Sheriff that he should take George Towne & Cole of Charles County Inholder of 1/2 and him wife & keep so that he should produce his body before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Neel County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March next & there answer unto William M'pherson of a Debt of five pounds the base and lawful and that he should have then and there that Writ.

At which day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid Comes the aforesaid William M'pherson by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney and offers himself against the said George and the Sheriff aforesaid Returns to the Court here that he has taken the body of the said Geo. Towne

And the aforesaid George in his proper Person Comes and defends the force and Injury when offered with that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of him the said William, nor but that he owes to the said William the sum of Nine pounds seven and Nine pence Sterling and no more

And thereupon the said William by his Attorney aforesaid prays Judgment and those Damages so aforesaid together with his Costs and Charges by him about this Suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged

Thereupon it is considered that the said William M'pherson Recover against the said George Towne his Damages to Nine pounds seven and Nine pence Sterling above acknowledged and also one hundred and Ninety Two pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about this Suit in this part laid out and Expended on his behalf by the Court here adjudged and the said George Towne in mercy &c

Know John Muschett D^r 4. 6. 6 Curancy
vs John Martin
Judgment by Cognovit Actionem

Charles County vs. John Martin Sen^r late of the said County Planter otherwise called John Martin was summoned to answer unto John Muschett of a plea that he rendered unto him the sum of four pounds six shillings and six pence Curancy which to him he owes and unjustly Detains &c

And thereupon the same John Muschett by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney with that where as the said John Martin on the Eight day of April in the year past did Seventeen shillings for five at Charles County aforesaid by his his Cousin William Obligatory signed with the hand and Name and sealed with the seal of him the said John Martin and here in Court brought whose date is this day and year past granted himself to be held and firmly bound unto the said John Muschett in the sum of four pounds six shillings and six pence Curancy to be paid unto the said John Muschett when thereunto aforesaid he should be required. Now the said John Martin altho' thereto requested by the said John Muschett to wit the 15th day of September in the year and at the County aforesaid and often afterwards hath not paid to the said John Muschett the said sum of four pounds six shillings and six pence Curancy or any part thereof but hitherto altogether hath and still doth Refuse to pay the same to the Damage of the said John Muschett Ten pounds Curancy and therefore bringing suit, and bringing here into Court the said Obligatory which gives sufficient proof and testimony of the said Debt the date whereof is the day and year aforesaid
