Come here will the said Joseph as the said John by their attorney and the said John by his said attorney pray further leave thereof to Imparle hereto until the next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March and the like and the same day is given the said Joseph here &c.

Whereupon into Court here in her proper person comes Eleanor Sanders of Charles County Widow and business Judge and security for the said John Sanders that if it should happen that the said John Sanders in the plea aforesaid should be bound that then the said Eleanor yielded and granted that as well for the same great cost and charge which is the same John Barber in this Court should be adjudged of his damages and costs should be made and levied to and for the use of the said John Barber if it should happen the said John Sanders the damages and costs aforesaid to the said John Barber should not pay or his body into the custody of the Sheriff by Reason thereof

And the said John Sanders by Henry Darnall his attorney comes and defends the plea and injury when &c. and pray leave thereof to Imparle hereto until the next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next and the like and the same day is given to the same John Barber here &c.
