George Jarvin }  
 Timothy Barrington } Judgment for Deft

Charles County J. Timothy Barrington late of Charles County Blanton was attached  
 to answer unto George Jarvin of a plea of Trepa upon the Case  
 And Whereupon the said George by Henry Darnall his attorney complains  
 for that he presents the said Timothy on the fourth day of June in the year our Lord one  
 thousand seven hundred and forty three of Charles County a. p. was made unto  
 the said George for the sum of seven hundred twenty five and a half Pounds of Tobacco  
 for divers Particulars lying Property in Account as by a Particular Account thereof shown  
 unto Court through his Paper and the said Timothy being thereof advised in  
 Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day on a year ago in the County a. p.  
 Upon himself presumed and to the said George then and there pitifully promised that  
 he the said Timothy the said sum of seven hundred twenty five and a half Pounds of Tobacco  
 to the said George would well and truly content and pay when thereunto afterwards he  
 should be required NEVER THELESS the said Timothy his Promise and Pardon  
 a. p. inform a. p. made note in the Court regarding but in finding and paid out by the said  
 him the said George in this manner to wit and liability to answer and defend the said  
 Timothy the said sum of seven hundred twenty five and a half Pounds of Tobacco or any  
 Part thereof the said George hath not paid or in any part contented with to do the said  
 Timothy on the Day of December the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred and forty four and after before and since at Charles County a. p.  
 by the said George requested but the said Timothy the said sum of seven hundred  
 twenty five and a half Pounds of Tobacco or any Part thereof to the said George to pay or  
 in any sort to content hath with to do together refused and will not refuse to the  
 Damage of him the said George one thousand five hundred and fifty one Pounds  
 of Tobacco and therefore he bringe suit &c.
