And whereupon the said James by Thomas Clats his attorney complains for that whereas the said John on the twenty sixth day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and forty five at Charles County aforesaid Subscribed unto the said James in the sum of Twelve hundred and five Shillings and five pence Currency for divers Certificates lying Property in certain lands by a Certificate account thereof which into Court brought by the said James and the said John being therein included James in violation thereof afterwards to wit the said year last mentioned at the County aforesaid upon himself he subscribed and to the same James Marten there faithfully promised that he would show the said James of Charles County five Shillings and five pence Currency to the said James would not thereby Content and they when they were afterwards he would be required Nevertheless the said John his Commission and Assumption aforesaid in fact made in the last Part being but in mind and fraudulent, inducing him the said James in this part of a false and Subtlely to deceive and defraud the said John the said sum of Twelve pounds five Shillings & five pence Currency or any part thereof to him the said James hath not Paid or in any sort Contented, altho' to do the said John Marten Junr. upon the first day of December last the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and forty five and often before and since at Charles County aforesaid by the said James Requested but the said John the said sum of Twelve pounds five Shillings and five pence Currency or any part thereof to him the said James to pay or in any sort to Content hath hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of him the said James Twenty four pounds four shillings and four pence Currency and the said James brought and forth
