the Promis and Assumption aforesaid to fourteen hundred and eight pds
of Tobacco as the said Edward above in Declaring supposes —

Whereupon the aforesaid

by Henry Damall his Attorney aforesaid pray Judgment and those
Damages so acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges
by him about his suit in the part laid out and Expended to him to be
Awarded.

NOTESTC it is considered by the Court heretofore
that the said Edward do recover against the said William his Damages
aforesaid to fourteen hundred and eleven pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid
and also the sum of Two Hundred and Eighty two pounds of Tobacco for his Costs
and Charges by him about his suit in the part laid out and Expended
Def in mind on his aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and the said William in mercy &c

thereof given unto the Court brought him by a person and the said William being so
thereof Informed to consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year
aforesaid he bounden himself upon him self bounden and to the said Edward then
and there faithfully Promised that the said William the said sum of Two
Thousand four Hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco to the said Edward would
