

March Court Anno Domini 1757

John Hanson Esq. vs. Henry Thompson Judgment for 3/4

This being an action upon the case for the Recovery of Damages according to the Directions of the Act of Assembly of this Province against the Transportation of Persons out of the Province without Passes brought by the said John Hanson Esq. against the said Henry Thompson. Whereupon the said Henry was by Verdict of a Jury as a Respondendum Returnable before his Honor the Justice Court of the second Tuesday in August in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and forty six, awarded. Thereupon the said John produces the bond of Charles County sh. It is shown all men by these presents that Daniel Brown of Charles County Esq. had and formerly bound unto John Hanson Esq. in the full & just sum of nine thousand eight hundred and fifty two pounds of Tobacco to be paid to the said John Hanson Esq. his heirs or assigns to which payment well and truly to be made and done, by and by my heirs, executors and administrators in the whole and for the whole firmly by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this 15th day of February in the 20th year of the said King's Majesty King George the Third.

The Condition of the above Obligation, is such that if the above bound Daniel Brown his heirs, executors or administrators do pay or cause to be paid unto the above named John Hanson Esq. his heirs or assigns the sum of one thousand nine hundred and twenty six pounds of Tobacco in Cash convenient in Charles County at or upon the 15th day of March next ensuing, then the above obligation, to be void of no effect but if default be made in the payments of the above a sum of one thousand nine hundred and twenty six pounds of Tobacco qualified aforesaid by the time above specified then I, the undersigned Attorney practicing in the Court of Record within this province, to appear for me and in my Name to confess Judgment for the sum above mentioned being one thousand nine hundred and twenty six pounds of Tobacco by Nichol Dick Cognovit actionem, Non solum Informatus or otherwise, finally releasing all the Errors that may happen in rendering said Judgment going out Execution or any the Proceedings thereto with my hand and seal the day and year above written.
