And Whereupon the same Samuel Hanson Junr. by his usual Chase his Attorney complains that whereas the said John Nally the Nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty four at Charles County aforesaid was indebted to the said Samuel Hanson Junr. in the sum of Twelve Hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco for diverse Articles lying & properly in an Account as by the Particular Account there of hereunto annexed and brought may appear and being so then of Indebted the aforesaid John in and in a-
 the of afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said Samuel Hanson Junr. then and there faithfully promised that he the aforesaid John the aforesaid sum of Twelve Hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco to the said Samuel Hanson Junr. when thereunto afterwards he should be required well and truly would content and pay

Nevertheless that the said John Nally his Promise and Assumption aforesaid not regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the same Samuel in this Partibusly and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid John Nally the aforesaid sum of Twelve Hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the same Samuel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort contented altho the aforesaid John Nally afterwards to wit the Tenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty five in or soon afterwards at Charles County aforesaid by the same Samuel hath been required but the same to him hither to, to pay or him for the same in any sort to content hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the same Samuel Hanson Junr. Two thousand four hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco and therefore suiter brought and set forth
