All now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo<sup>r</sup> comes  
The aforesaid Samuel Benjamin Chase his attorney afo<sup>r</sup> and offers  
him self against the said John in the said afo<sup>r</sup> and on <sup>the</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Morons Namely Master  
James Gant Planter to this witness that the said John in his walk with  
is no found and that he hath left according to the directions of the act of Assembly in  
those cases late made and provided a copy of the following Declaration viz

**Charles Cowen Esq<sup>r</sup>** John Nally late of Charles County Planter was attacked to  
answer unto Samuel Hanson Jun<sup>r</sup> High Sheriff of Charles County of this shire upon  
upon the cause

**Mic Whetelson** the same Samuel Hanson by his attorney aforesaid  
Attorney complains that whereas the said John on the sixteenth day of  
December in the year our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and forty four of Charles  
County aforesaid was indebted to the said Samuel Hanson Jun<sup>r</sup> in the sum of  
Twelve hundred and Twenty five pounds of tobacco for divers articles lying  
properly in an account aforesaid by the particular account there of now to be brought  
brought may appear and being so much of Indebtedness <sup>Kaily</sup> in consideration  
thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon  
himself assumed and to the said Samuel Hanson Jun<sup>r</sup> then and there faithfully  
Promised that he the aforesaid John the aforesaid sum of twelve hundred and  
Twenty five pounds of tobacco to the said Samuel Hanson Jun<sup>r</sup> when thereunto  
afterwards he should be required well and truly would content and pay

NEVERTHELESS that the aforesaid John Nally his promise and agreement afo<sup>r</sup> not  
regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the same Samuel in this  
particular and subtilty to receive and defraud the aforesaid John Nally the  
afo<sup>r</sup> sum of twelve hundred and Twenty five pounds of tobacco or any part  
thereof to the same Samuel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort but only  
alio the aforesaid John Nally afterwards to wit the ninth day of February in  
the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and forty five and often  
afterwards at Charles County afo<sup>r</sup> by the same Samuel hath been required  
but the same to him hither to to pay or him for the same in any sort to content him  
hither to altogether refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same  
Samuel Hanson Jun<sup>r</sup> Two thousand four hundred and fifty four pounds of tobacco  
and therefore suit is brought and so forth
