Whereupon the said Daniel by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney etc. All and singular the Prerogatives by Act of Assembly on Part of the said Daniel being performed they Judgment for the writ of the Lord Proprietary of Attachment to show Returnable here etc. against the goods Chattels & Credits against the said Peter in the Jurisdiction of the Court these being for as well the Damages etc. as for what Costs have accrued and that further may accrue in Prosecution of the Premises

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Daniel have the Writ of the Lord Proprietary of Attachment Returnable here etc. against the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Peter within the Jurisdiction of the Court here being for as well the Sum of Eight Hundred Ninety pounds two Shillings & sixpence of Tobacco as well Costs which have accrued in and about the Premises and that may here after accrue in Prosecution of the said Writ of Attachment by the Court here as judged according to the Form and Effect of the Act of Assembly aforesaid

Charles County etc. Joseph Harrison late of Charles County Plaintiff was attached to answer unto Samuel Harrison junior of a plea of Assumpsit upon the following facts

That the said Samuel by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney complains that whereas the said Joseph Harrison the Defendant on the twenty ninth day of September in the year past paid one thousand seven hundred and forty seven at Charles County etc. and indebted to the said Samuel Harrison in the sum of Eighteen Hundred and fifty three pounds of Tobacco and four shillings and four pence Current Money for several Articles lying proper upon account as by the Particulars hereof here with into Court brought may appear and being so thereupon the said Joseph Harrison in consideration thereof promised to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County etc. upon himself & his heirs and assigns to the said Samuel then and thereafter fully to provide that he the said Joseph Harrison the said Defendant of Eighteen Hundred and fifty three pounds of Tobacco and two shillings of four Pence Current Money to the said Samuel when the said Defendant should be requested, well and truly would content and pay nevertheless the said Joseph his promise of performance aforesaid not regarding but minding a fraudulent and intending the same Samuel in this Court of his and Subtily to deceive and defraud the said Joseph the said sum of Eighteen Hundred and fifty three pounds of Tobacco and four shillings and four Pence Current Money or any part thereof to the same Samuel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented altho the said Joseph after the first day of October in the year past paid one thousand seven hundred and forty seven and after at Charles County etc. by the same Samuel hath been Requested, but the same to him hither to, to pay or him for the same in any sort Contented hath hither to altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the same Samuel Harrison Five thousand seven hundred and sixpence of Tobacco and four shillings and eight Pence Current Money and the said Samuel's lawyer's charges
