Writ upon into Court in his Proper Person before Samuel Hanson
of Charles County Gentleman and his Bond and Security for the said
Joseph that if it should happen the said Script in the plea a^p. should be
Convict that then the said Samuel Hanson yeild and grant that as
well the Damages a^p. as all Costs to which to the said John will have
in that this part should be adjudged of his Land & Chattels should be made
and Levied to and for the use of the said Samuel Hanson and that if it should
happen that the said Joseph the Damages & Costs a^p. to the said Samuel
Hanson and should not Pay or his Day in to the custody of the Sheriff by
Reason thereof Render.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in

March a^p. Comes as well the said Joseph as the said Samuel his Attorney
and he aged Samuel by his attorney a^p. pray that this act go
to his Declaration against him may answer and the said Joseph by his
Attorney a^p. comes and defend so therefore and Injury when &c. and the said
attorney says that he is not informed of any Answer to the said Samuel for
this said Joseph in the plea a^p. to begin and nothing other thereto doth he
say whereby the same Samuel Remains against the said Joseph —
Thereupon without Default

It is therefore considered by the Court here

that the said Samuel do Recover against the said Joseph His Damages
by reason of the Damages to Eighteen Hundred and Fifty Three pounds
of Tobacco and Two Shillings and four Pence money as also Two Hundred &
Nineteen Pounds of Tobacco before the Inspection Laying Sixty Three Pounds of Inspected Tobacco
for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Court and Expenditure to
Defend the said Samuel of his Agent by the Court here Adjudged and the said Joseph in Money &c.
