The Damages and Costs afo^r to the said John July should not be y^e his body into the
Custody into the hands of the Sheriff by Reason thereof And the said John in
his Proper Person Comes and depends the fore and Injury when He and says that he
cannot deny the Action afo^r of him the said John nor that he did assume upon himself
in manner and form as the said John against him hath complained nor do he but that
the said John hath sustained Damages by reason of not performing the Promises and
Assumptions afo^r to seven Hundred and fourteen Pounds of Tobacco and no more

Whereupon the said John by Sermon Chase their Attorney afo^r prays Judgment and
that Damages be acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges by him about his
Suit in this part And said he prays to be adjudged Therefore it is considered by
the Court here that the said John do recover against the said Herkshire his Damages afo^r to
seven Hundred and fourteen Pounds of Tobacco above acknowledged as also the sum of one
Hundred and twenty four Pounds of Tobacco before the Imprestion save fifty one p^{er} cent
of a pound of Inspected Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part said

And said he prays to be adjudged and the said Herkshire in Mercy
of his own cost and Expence doth satisfy by the Court here adjudged and the said Herkshire in Mercy

Judgment of Cognovit Actionem

That as County of John Maury late of Charles County Clerk was attached to answer unto
Samuel Hanson Jun^r of the County of Augusta the said Hanson
And Whereupon the said Samuel by Sermon Chase his Attorney complains that
whereas the said John the first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven Hundred
forty seven at Charles County afo^r was indebted to the said Samuel in the sum of Nineteen
Hundred and forty one Pounds of Tobacco and six shillings and five Pence Currency for divers
Particulars being Properly in an Account by the Particulars amount thereof herewith into Court
brought and displayed and being thereof indebted the said John in London upon the said Hanson
to wit the day and year afo^r at the County afo^r upon himself assumed and to the said
Samuel then and there faithfully promised that he the said John the said sum of Nineteen Hundred
and forty one Pounds of Tobacco and six shillings and five Pence Currency to the said Samuel
when thereunto afterwards he should be legally and truly obliged Content and Pay
Nevertheless the said John his Promise and Assumption afo^r not regarding but hindering
and fraudulently Intending the same should in this Particularity and Deliberately
deceive and defraud the said Samuel the said sum of Nineteen Hundred and forty one Pounds of
Tobacco and six shillings and five Pence Currency or any Part thereof to the said Samuel
hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented with the said John afterwards to
wit the first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and forty
seven and often afterwards at Charles County afo^r by the said Samuel hath been Requested
but the same to him to wit to pay other for the same in any sort to Content hath
hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the said Samuel three
thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Two Pounds of Tobacco and Twelve Shilling of
Pence Currency and there fore suites brought and so forth
