Whereupon into Court there in his proper Person comes Hugh Dornie of Charles County Merchant and becomes Plaintiff & Petitioner for the said John that if it should happen the said John in the place afo^r should be convicted that then the said Hugh guided and granted that as well the Damages afo^r as all costs which to the said Samuel in this part should be adjudged of his Lands and Chattels should be made and paid to and for the use of the said Samuel that if it should happen that the said John the Damages and Costs afo^r to the said Samuel should not pay or his body in to the hands of the Sheriff by reason thereof render — And the afo^r John in his proper Person comes and defends the force and injury whereof &c. and says that he cannot deny the petition afo^r of him the said Samuel nor that he did afo^r upon himself on an error and form afo^r the said Samuel against him hath complained nor also but that the said Samuel hath sustained Damages by means of not performing the Promises afo^r of pounds afo^r to one Thomas and three Hundred and ^{forty five} pounds of Tobacco & six shillings and six pence Currency as the said Samuel above in the last single purpose —

Whereupon the said Samuel by counsel chose their attorneys & pray Judgment and the Damages so acknowledged together with his costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged —

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Samuel do recover against the said John his Damages afo^r to Ninety Hundred and forty one Pound of Tobacco & six shillings and six pence Currency above acknowledged as also the sum of Five Hundred and thirty seven Pound of Tobacco before the Inspection save ^{the} Seven Pound of Inspected Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that Part laid out and Expended on his afo^r by the Court here adjudged and the said John that
