Complains that whereas the said Thomas the Nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty six at Charles County aforesaid was indebted to the said William Reynolds in the sum of Six pounds Cunney, for divers articles being Property in an amount as by the Particular Accoues thereof with into Court brought may appear and being so there of Induced thereto Thomas in Consideration whereof afterwards w^t th^e day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon his selfe affirmed and to the said William then and there faithfully Promised that he the aforesaid Thomas the aforesaid sum of six pounds Cunney to the said William shentheunto afterwardes he should be Requested well and truly would Content and pay Nevertheles^s he aforesaid Thomas his Promise and assumption aforesaid not regarding Calumniing and Fraudulently Intending the same In this past Craftily and Subtilty to devide and Deprive the aforesaid Thomas the aforesaid sum of six pounds Cunney or any part thereof to the same William hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contred altho^t the aforesaid Thomas afterwards w^t th^e first day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty seven and afwa^rd at Charles County aforesaid hath been Requested but the same to him neither to pay or him for the same in any sort to Content heth either to altogether Refuse and still doth refuse to the Damage of the same William Twelve pounds Cunney and therefor suit is brought and so forth.

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes William Middleton of Charles County Merchant and bears Bledge and Security for the said Thomas that if it should happen th^e said Thomas in the file aforesaid should be Convict that then the said Thomas yielded and granted that as well the Damages aforesaid as all Costs which to the said William Reynolds in this part should of his Lands and Chattels should be made and paid toward for the use of the said Reynolds that if it should happen that the said Thomas the Damages and Costs aforesaid to the said William Reynolds should not Pay or be body into the Custody of the Sheriff by Reason thereof Provider

And th^e said Thomas in his proper Person comes and defends the same and sayeth when^t he cannot deny the action aforesaid of him the said William Reynolds nor but that he did affirme upon himself in manner and form as the said Thomas against him hath complained nor also but that the said W^m hath sustained Damages by means of not performing the promises and assumptions aforesaid to six pounds Cunney as the said William above induring his suit
