Thereupon the said James by Thomas Clark his Attorney Comed and Prays that the said John Rowland Jun. be being a non Resident in the County afo. may give security for the costs which the said James may Expens in prosecuting his suit according to the Rules and Practices here

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person Comes Walter Hanson of Charles County Merchant and becomes Pledge and Security for the said John that in case the said John discontinues the Plea afo. against the said James or in the case be Non suit that then the said Walter yielded and Granted that all singular the costs which to the said James should be adjudged of his Land & Chattels should be made and paid unto the said John should he pay and satisfy the same to the said James or his body in Execution by Reason hereof Pender

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person Comes Jacob Anderson M. in. of Charles County Jurer and becomes Pledge and Security for the said James that if it should happen the said James in the Plea afo. should be convicted that then the said Jacob yielded and granted that he will the damages afo. as all costs which to the said John in the Plea should be adjudged of his Land and Chattels should be made and paid to and for the use of the said John that if it should happen that the said James the damages and costs afo. to the said John should not pay or his body in to the custody of the Sheriff by Reason hereof Pender

And the said James by Thomas Clark his Attorney Comed and Prays that the said John be bound to the said James for the sum of £100 and say that he cannot deny the action afo. of the said John nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said John against him hath complained nor less but that the said John hath sustained Damage by means of not performing the Promises and Assumptions afo. said to Eleven Hundred Ninety five pounds of Tobacco as the said John above in declaring he supposed

Whereupon the said John by Jemiah Chase their Attorney afo. prays Judgment
