thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the said Proprietary of his Great
County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next
then and there to be condemned according to Law to and for the use of the said Debt
Unless the said John should Come then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney
Answer unto the said Robert of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and that by Law
Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make known to the Person or Persons
whom he should make the same attachment that he shoud they should appear
before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the time and Place afo^d. to show cause
if any he shoud or they have in their or any of their hands attached should not
be condemned according to Law and the said Robert have the use of Execution. if y^e
and here he should Recite that the said Robert should make known to the Justice
aforesaid at the Time and Place afo^d. an attachment should have then and there that
with in the Name of these before whom he should make the same known &c

Robert by Jeremiah Chase his attorney and offers himself against the said
